- A widow opened her home (Tuding) for us to study together. Our team visited her today and gave words of encouragement. Her son-in-law died of cardiac arrest the other week. She requested for a weekly get together for sharing and strengthening one another.
- Annie and I visited our Muslim friend Asliah and her family whose house was flooded during the previous typhoon Florida. Some like-minded friends donated funds for them to buy galvanized iron sheets for their walls and roofing.

The people needed encouragement and moral support after many of them lost their homes and businesses. We stayed there 2 days visited a few homes and cared for those who were depressed due to the disaster.
